Structure

2 Semesters + 1 curricular internship + Induction Programme (150h).

The Course in Nature and Adventure Tourism has a duration of 1 year (full-time), divided into 2 semesters, including a curricular internship of 500h duration. Students have the opportunity to select reference tourism information and entertainment companies and events to carry out their internship.

Induction Program

Induction Programme (150h) consists of a beginner-level training programme aimed at students with no previous training or experience in the area.
